Re: Response to TCEQ Notice of Deficiency Letter Dated June 21, 2011, Trinity Oaks Landfill, Groundwater Monitoring Well System Revision Permit Modification; MSW Permit No. 556, Dallas County, Texas; Tracking Nos. 14705015 and 14736750; RN100217942/CN601541469

Dear Mr. Zeng:

This letter is written on behalf of the Trinity Oaks Landfill in response to a Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) letter dated June 21, 2011. The letter requested that the TCEQ comments be addressed within 30 days (July 21, 2011). The TCEQ's comment is provided below in italics, with our response immediately following.

Comment: We have reviewed your response to our NOD letter including a Statement of Property Access and its attachments. Based on our internal consultations, the submitted document is believed not sufficient to record the offsite wells as part of the referenced permit. To properly record/include the offsite wells as part of the permit, the applicant may take one of the three actions listed below:

1. *To modify the facility boundary to include any offsite monitoring wells. This option also requires Part I Application Form Part D, a legal description(s) in accordance with §330.59(d)(1)(A) – (D) and property owner affidavit(s) for the offsite parcel(s) in accordance with §330.59(d)(2).*
2. *To file a dedicated easement recorded in the Dallas County real property records. This option also requires Part I Application Form Part D, a legal description(s) in accordance with §330.59(d)(1)(A) – (D) and property owner affidavit(s) for the offsite parcel(s) in accordance with §330.59(d)(2).*
3. *To deed record modified property owner's affidavit(s) for the parcel(s) where the offsite wells will be located prior to installation of the offsite wells and provide Part I Application*


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Form Part D, a legal description(s) in accordance with §330.59(d)(1)(A) – (D) along with the proof that the required deed recordation has occurred (please include a copy of the deed record document accepted by the county). The applicant may elect to 'carve out' a property description or descriptions that specifically encompass the monitoring wells instead of identifying the entire parcel on the property owner affidavit and property description. Attached to this letter for your use is a sample modified affidavit.

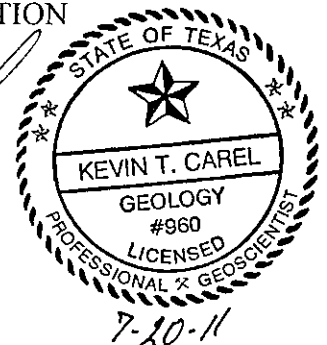
Response: The facility agrees to implement one of the three options listed in the NOD response letter. These options involve the legal and real property departments within Republic Services, as well as coordinating with Dallas County, therefore the requested actions cannot be completed within the 30 day response period listed in your letter. The facility respectfully requests an additional 45 days to provide the appropriate paperwork. If this is acceptable, a response letter with the finalized documentation will be submitted by September 4, 2011.
